

Dear Residents,

The Village of Bayville is launching a Recycling Awareness / Education Campaign to improve our recycling program. This Campaign which was developed with input from the Bayville Environmental Conservation Commission will benefit our environment and reduce waste disposal costs for the Village.

During the week of August 24, 2015, on your regular recycling day, all households will receive a new blue 20-gallon recycling pail. On the other side of this letter, is a recycling chart that can be used as a reference guide.

Residents should be aware that all plastic may be recycled. Cardboard, all food boxes, as well as newspaper and various junk mail, need to be **flattened** and **tied** separately. Styrofoam in any form cannot be recycled.

Remember—the most important part of this program is **YOU** and your household’s participation. Please join in the effort to protect our environment.

Please Note: The Sanitation Department will continue to pick up recyclables on your designated day.
