


2016 KIDS CONSERVATION CONTEST

The purpose of the contest is to generate awareness and action in solving some of the environmental issues facing our community.

Participating students will propose a solution to the following environmental problem:

Please see the attached Nitrogen Loading Map supplied by The Nature Conservancy and provide an answer to some or all of the questions:

What is Nitrogen Loading?

What are its causes?

Who does it affect?

What can we do as an individual, homeowner, village to help prevent this problem?

In the form of written report, poster or video the student/s will explain the following:

What problem are you trying to solve?

What negative effects is the problem causing Bayville's environment?

What is the proposed solution?

How will you evaluate if the idea is working?

Projects will be judged on:

Understanding of the issue

Practicality and creativity of the proposed solution

The winners will get bragging rights and will participate and receive recognition at a village meeting.
