# §72-3 Permit required; exception.

A. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove, destroy, or substantially alter the habit of one or more of the live trees or a dead tree on any parcel of real property unless a permit has been obtained pursuant to this chapter.

# §72-5 Application for permit.

A. Whenever a person shall deem it necessary to remove, destroy, or substantially alter one or more of the live trees or a dead tree on any real property within the Village, such person shall first make application for a permit to the Village Board.

**SECTION II. Effective date.** This local law shall take effect upon the filing with the Department of State.

SECTION I. Amend Section 3-2, "Definitions," in part to read as follows:

## § 3-2 Definitions.

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

#### AIRCRAFT

Any weight-carrying machine or structure for flight in or navigation of the air and designed to be supported by the air either by the buoyancy of the structure or by the dynamic action of the air against its surfaces. The term "aircraft" shall be understood to include airplanes (including seaplanes), helicopters, and drones.

#### **EMERGENCY**

A situation or circumstance endangering the life or limb of the pilot or passengers of an aircraft.

SECTION III. This local law shall take effect upon the filing with the Department of State.
