

Village of Bayville Early Mail Ballot Application

Please print clearly. See detailed instructions on reverse side.

To receive an early mail ballot: **In-Person:** Application must be personally delivered to the village clerk's office not later than the day before the election. *Election Law § 15-119(7)*. **By Mail:** Application must be received by the village clerk's office not later than the 7th day before the election. *Election Law § 15-119(7)*.

The ballot itself must be received by the village clerk's office no later than the close of polls on Election Day in order to be canvassed. *Election Law § 15-119(10)*.

Instructions:**Who may apply for an early mail ballot?**

Each person must apply for themselves. It is a felony to make a false statement in an application for an early mail ballot, to attempt to cast an illegal ballot, or to help anyone to cast an illegal ballot.

Where and when to return your application:

Applications must be mailed seven days before the election, or hand-delivered to your Village Clerk by the day before the election. Mailing address is:

Options available to you if you have an illness or disability:

You may sign the early mail ballot application yourself, or you may make your mark and have your mark witnessed in the spaces provided on the bottom of the application. Please note that a power-of-attorney or printed name stamp is not allowed for any voting purpose.

When your ballot will be sent:

Your early mail ballot materials will be sent to you at least 6 days before the election in which you are eligible to vote. If applicant or agent delivers the application to the Village Clerk in person after the seventh day before the village election and not later than the day before the election, the Village Clerk shall deliver such early mail ballots for those applicants or their agents named in the application when such applicants or agents appear in the Village Clerk's office.

Instrucciones:**¿Quién puede solicitar una boleta electoral por correo anticipado?**

Cada persona debe presentar una solicitud por sí misma. Es delito grave hacer una declaración falsa en una solicitud

de boleta electoral por correo anticipado, intentar emitir una boleta electoral ilegal o ayudar a alguien a emitir una boleta electoral ilegal.

Dónde y cuándo devolver su solicitud:

Las solicitudes deben enviarse por correo siete días antes de la elección, o entregarse en mano en la Secretaría de la villa

hasta el día antes de la elección. La dirección postal es:

Opciones disponibles en caso de enfermedad o discapacidad:

Puede firmar la solicitud de boleta electoral por correo anticipado usted mismo, o puede realizar su marca y hacer que esta sea atestiguada en los espacios provistos en la parte inferior de la solicitud. Tenga en cuenta que no se permite un poder legal ni un sello de un nombre preimpreso para cualquier propósito de votación.

Cuándo se enviará su boleta electoral:

Se le enviarán los materiales relacionados con las boletas electorales por correo anticipado al menos 6 días antes de la elección en la que es

elegible para votar. Si el solicitante o agente entrega la solicitud a la Secretaría de la villa en persona después del

séptimo día antes de la elección de la villa y antes del día previo a la elección, la

Secretaría de la villa entregará tales boletas electorales por correo anticipado para los solicitantes o sus agentes nombrados en la

solicitud cuando tales solicitantes o agentes se presenten en la oficina de la Secretaría de la villa.
